# POLICY

- **TITLE:** SPC 14 Land Management: Executive Orders
- **ADOPTED:** June 29, 2015 (Effective: July 1, 2015)

### **REVISED:**

### 1. Definitions

- (a) <u>State Properties Commission</u>: The State's real estate portfolio manager responsible for all acquisitions and dispositions of State owned real property interests as created by O.C.G.A. 50-16-32. The members of the governing body thereof are collectively referred to as the "Commission".
- (b) <u>Executive Order</u>: For the Commission's purposes, an order or instruction from the Governor, in regard to State-owned real property which does not require the approval of the General Assembly.
- (c) <u>Agency</u>: The State agency having custody of a State-owned real property; which may also be the current or previous user.
- (d) <u>Property</u>: Any State of Georgia-owned real property as defined in O.C.G.A. 50-16-31 (8A-8F).

#### 2. Purpose

To provide an administrative process for handling Executive Order requests from an Agency for either:

- the transfer of custody of Property between Agencies, or
- the demolition of structures located on any Property.

#### **3. Policy Statement**

(a) Executive Order requests require the Governor's signature and Commission staff shall follow the respective process for an Agency's Executive Order request, which is outlined in the Commission's Standard Operating Procedures.

**Executive Orders** 

Effective: July 1, 2015

#### Definitions

- (a) <u>State Properties Commission (SPC)</u>: The State's real estate portfolio manager responsible for all acquisitions and dispositions of State owned real property interests and is created by O.C.G.A. 50-16-32. The members of the governing body thereof are collectively referred to as the "SPC".
- (b) <u>Executive Order</u>: For SPC's purposes, an order or instruction from the Governor, in regard to State-owned real property which does not require the approval of the General Assembly.
- (c) <u>Action Request:</u> Any required board resolutions or constitutional officer letters, instructions, forms, documents, and checklists which each agency must provide or complete to request a real property action of SPC.
- (d) <u>Agency</u>: The State agency having custody of a State-owned real property; which may also be the current or previous user.
- (e) <u>Property:</u> Any State of Georgia-owned real property as defined in O.C.G.A. 50-16-31 (8A-8F).

#### Purpose

To provide an administrative process for handling Executive Order requests from an Agency for either:

- the transfer of custody of Property between Agencies, or
- the demolition of structures located on any Property.

#### Procedure

- 1. An Agency initiates an Executive Order request through submission of a completed Action Request to SPC. For custody transfer requests, both the giving and receiving Agencies must submit the required Action Request information.
- 2. Upon receipt of a completed Action Request(s), SPC staff will review submitted material and draft the Executive Order for submittal to the Governor's office for the Governor's signature.
- 3. After receipt and inventory of the executed Executive Order, SPC staff will forward a copy of the final document to the requesting Agency(ies).
