The Leasing Specialist (LS) II must have knowledge of lease negotiation policies and practices, leasing contract documents and procedures, space management practices, market analysis, project management and effective communication methods for various types of highly complex leasing projects.

Minimum Qualifications (Agency Specific): Completion of a degree in Business Administration, Real Estate, Finance or related field combined with four (4) years of experience in negotiating, reviewing, drafting and managing leases OR Completion of a degree in Business Administration Real Estate, Finance or related field combined with six (6) years of project management experience related to the acquisition of leased or owned space.

<u>Competencies:</u> Knowledge of state laws that regulate many aspects of tenant/landlord relationships. Customer service focus with excellent written and verbal communication skills. Ability to work independently to manage multiple leases while meeting strict deadlines in a fast paced environment. Strong problem solving skills are essential and attention to detail with ability to work quickly with changing priorities. Must be a team player with initiative and flexibility. Proficient in the use of Microsoft Office.
